

The majority of Americans show support for

Voters overwhelmingly want the government to **prioritize quality**, **cost**, **and reputation over politics** and need to be further educated on the meaning of ESG.

An overwhelming majority of voters want the government to keep politics out of contracting decisions. **70% of voters want** state officials to prioritize quality, cost, and reputation of the product and company over decisions the company has made on political issues.

METHODOLOGY: The key findings and data shared in this one-pager come from Centerline Liberties' recent national survey of 800 registered voters conducted September 12-16, 2024, via mixed mode methodology (cell phones, landlines, online and text-to-web). The survey has a margin of error of +/- 3%.
